**SCHOLARSHIP CATEGORIES:**

- 1) A person in high school or above that has demonstrated an innovative approach towards being (green initiative) environment friendly (Provide Letter of Intent).
- 2) a post-secondary student enrolled in an engineering or technology related field of study at a recognized university, college, or technical school in BC
- 3) a high school student (grade 12) planning on pursuing post-secondary studies upon graduation in an engineering or technology related field of study.
- 4) a new immigrant (max. of 1 year since arrival to Canada) pursuing post-secondary studies in an engineering or technology related field of study.

**MINIMUM ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA**

1. The applicants for the **post-secondary student** category must fulfill the following requirements:
  - a) Be registered as a full-time student in a post secondary institute (university, technical institute, or college) within the Province of BC for the current year.
  - b) Be enrolled in an engineering related field of study.
2. The applicants for the **immigrant student** category must fulfill the following requirements:
  - a) Be registered as a full-time student in a post secondary institute (university, technical institute, or college) within the Province of BC for the current year.
  - b) Be enrolled in an engineering related field of study.
  - c) Must be registered for at least three technical courses in a post secondary institution.
  - d) A person will be considered a new immigrant if he/she has arrived in Canada after December 1, 2010.
3. The applicants for the **high-school student** category must fulfill the following requirements:
  - a) Be registered as a full-time student in grade 12 at a high school in BC.
  - b) Plan on pursuing post-secondary studies upon graduation in an engineering or technology related field of study.

4. The applicants for the **innovative approach towards being environment friendly** category must fulfill the following requirements:
- a) Provide a letter of intent, clearly identifying their own ideas about sustainability.
  - b) Their participation / involvement in the local green initiatives.

**SELECTION CRITERIA**

Recipients for the Awards will be determined by:

- Academic Achievement
- Needs basis as determined by the application form
- Involvement in Extra-curricular activities (especially involvement in either Indo-Canadian activities or activities related to the Engineering profession)

A person can be awarded only one scholarship in a period of three consecutive years.

The SPEATBC Executive Committee has the sole right to:

- determine the number of scholarships to be awarded each year,
- determine the amount of each scholarship, and
- select the winning recipients of the scholarship awards.

The SPEATBC Executive Committee will make its best efforts to award these four scholarships of \$700 each at the SPEATBC Annual Dinner in January 2012.
